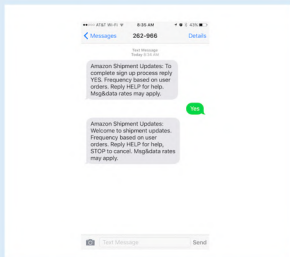
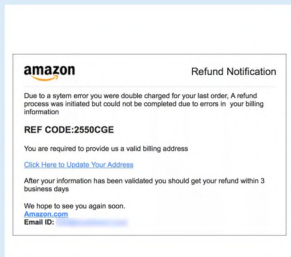
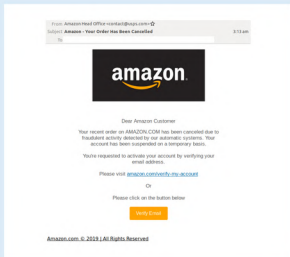
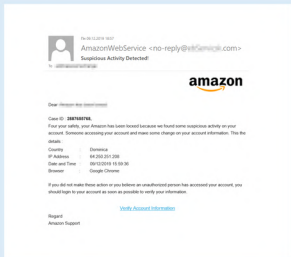


# AMAZON.COM SCAMS!!!

Don't open any attachments or click on any links form suspicious emails or texts!



Fraudulent communications attempt to gather personal information through email, SMS (text), and phone calls.

A fraudulent email or SMS message can appear to be from Amazon and ask you to confirm your personal information. But look closely these messages many contain spelling and grammar errors. They provide links to sites other than Amazon.

Always go directly to the Amazon.com website and check the "Your Orders" section to take any actions related to orders. Amazon.com never requests payment or offers refunds for something you are not expecting. When in doubt always verify on the Amazon.com website.
