**THE ROLE**

The Richmond County District Attorney's Office is seeking a full-time admitted Attorney to serve as the Deputy Bureau Chief of the Domestic Violence Bureau. Under the supervision of the Chief of the Domestic Violence Bureau, the Deputy Chief will be responsible for the following:

- Assist the Bureau Chief in overseeing and managing the day-to-day operations of the Domestic Violence Bureau, whose jurisdiction includes, but is not limited to, complaint writing, handling arraignments, trial preparation and overall prosecution of misdemeanors
- Assist the Bureau Chief in ensuring that the policies of the District Attorney's (DA) are implemented
- Represent the Bureau Chief at suppression hearings and trials
- Provide guidance and mentoring to Bureau ADAs regarding ethical responsibilities, completeness of drafted complaints, making offers and recommending bail
- Interact with the Supreme Court Bureau, other criminal justice partners, and ensure that the appropriate Chiefs are consulted on felony cases

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

1. New York Bar admission
2. Must be a New York State resident.

- Supervisory experience and foreign language skills a plus;
- At least 6 years' experience in prosecuting misdemeanors;
- Strong analytical, organizational, written and oral communication skills;
