THE ROLE

Under the direct supervision of the Paralegal Supervisor, the candidate will serve as a Discovery Specialist. Duties will include, but not limited to the following:

- Assist ADA's by requesting and obtaining discovery materials, including, but not limited to, 911 calls, laboratory reports, NYPD records, and OCME records.
- Monitor and download incoming DNA, Toxicology and OCME notifications and reports
- Upload Discovery into the digital case files
- Working collaboratively with NYPD discovery contacts
- Other general clerical duties as assigned

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

1. High school graduation or equivalent and three years of experience in community work or community centered activities in an area related to duties described above; or
2. Education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1" above.
